


9514 & 9514-25 CANISTER REPAIR/REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1



•Remove the 4 sheet metal screws fastening the blower to the duct canister.

STEP 3




• Pull a short amount of ducting through the canister.

STEP 2



•Separate the blower from the duct canister as shown.

STEP 4




•Slide ducting onto the blower past the blower lip as shown. Securely fasten the hose clamp screw, aligned on the side as shown.

STEP 5



•Assemble the duct canister onto the blower by allowing the canister to clear the hose clamp screw aligned on the side.

STEP 7



•Align the existing holes on the duct canister and blower. Securely fasten the duct canister onto the blower being careful not to over-torque the sheet metal screws.

STEP 6



•Once the hose clamp screw is clear of obstruction, continue to slide the duct canister onto the blower.
