
Installation Instructions and Surface Preparation for PERMALIGHT® self-adhesive Wall- and Corner Guards

PERMALIGHT® self-adhesive Wall- and Corner Guards come with a strong self-adhesive backing. Even if an installation surface looks clean, it may have accumulated a layer of dust or grimy sheen over time generated by age, wear and dirt in the installation environment. Here are a few easy Surface Preparation steps that assure a long-term adhesive bond.

- 1. We recommend wiping over the installation surface with water on microfiber cloth.
- 2. For rather dirty, grimy surfaces, next wipe installation surface a second time, now with isopropyl alcohol applied to a different microfiber cloth. Once that is evaporated, the surface is excellently surface-prepped for the adhesivebacked polyurethane foam guard to stick durably and reliably.
- 3. If you want to cut the polyurethane foam guard to a specific length, hold it in place with the adhesive still protected by its silicone paper. Cut the foam guard to your desired length, using a utility knife with a fresh blade. ! Careful do not cut yourself!
- 4. Remove the silicone paper from the adhesive backing withOUT touching the adhesive itself. Hold the foam guard along its sides to keep the strong adhesive free of finger prints.
- 5. Firmly press-apply the foam guard in place. Do NOT pull it off to re-align or re-adjust. The self-adhesiveness is its strongest when it is pressed in the right spot with the first application. Any removing and re-applying will lessen the initial strongest bond.
