
Tools Needed: Phillips Head Screwdriver Please read all instructions before assembly.


- Step 1: Insert Seat Braces (A) into the Chair Frame (B) holes.
- Step 2: Attach Chair Seat (C) to frame by inserting M6x45mm Screws (F) and Washers (G) through Seat Brace (A) and into the pre-drilled holes in the Chair Seat (C). Tighten screws with Allen Wrench (I), provided, or use screwdriver.
- Step 3: Attach Chair Back (D) to frame by inserting M6x20mm Screws (E) and Washers (G) through metal tabs and into the pre-drilled holes in the Chair Back (D). Tighten screws with Allen Wrench (I), provided, or use screwdriver.
- Step 4: Cover Screws (E) and metal tabs with Back Covers (H).


 Press firmly to secure.
- Step 5: Insert the adjustable Leveling Glides (J) into the bottomr of the chair legs, if desired.

During assembly, hand tighten screws only. When all screws are in place, you may then tighten all screws completely.
