Manufacturing Warranty

Each new exhaust fan motor and prop is warranted to be free from defects in material or workmanship for 2 years from the date of new installation by the original purchaser.

If a component is found to be defective in this 2 year period, it will either be repaired or replaced at the option of the factory.

CAUTION: Guards must be used when fan is mounted within reach of personnel or fan must be mounted 7ft above work surface.



Grease bearings	Annually	Lightly grease pillow block bearings. Do not over grease.	
(belt drive models only)		Too much grease will cause bearing seals to fail.	
Clean motor and blade	As Needed	Blow off dust/debris with air hose and nozzle.	
		Use a damp cloth to clean motor and blade.	
		Do not pressure wash. Pressure washing will void warranty.	
Check belt tensioner	Bi-annually	Assure belt deflection is no more than 3/4" at 10lbs of force.	
Lubricate motor	N/A	Motors are sealed and permanently lubricated.	
		No further lubrication necessary.
